

# Oregon Transportation Commission (OTC)

Five member volunteer citizen board. Governor appoints, with consent of Oregon Senate, considers geographic regions, at least one member must live east of Cascades, no more than three may belong to same political party, serve a four-year term and may be re-appointed. Responsibilities:

- Develop and maintain state transportation policy and a comprehensive, long-range plan for a multimodal transportation system.
- Coordinate and administer programs relating to railways, highways, motor vehicles, public transit, transportation safety and other transportation related programs.
- Meet monthly, sometimes at different locations around the state.

## **ORS 184.618(1)**

As its primary duty, the [OTC] shall develop and maintain a state transportation policy and a comprehensive, long-range plan for a safe, multimodal transportation system for the state which encompasses economic efficiency, orderly economic development and environmental quality.

## **ORS 184.616 (1)**

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the OTC has the power to adopt any rules, establish any policy or exercise any other duty, function or power where a statute gives such power to ODOT.
