US97 (Hwy 4)	Bend North City Limits (MP 133.39)	Empire Ave (MP 135.46)	2.07	This is an important segment of the US 97 Statewide freight corridor on the north end of Bend that connects US 97 to the City's largest industrial area on Empire Ave that generates freight.
US97 (Hwy 4)	Reed Lane (MP 139.68)	3 rd Street Connection (MP 140.87)	1.19	Statewide freight corridor. This is an important freight segment of US97 in the Bend MPO.
US20 (Hwy 17)	Old Bend-Redmond Hwy	Empire Ave (MP 18.80)	2.07	Statewide freight corridor. There will be significant land use development along this highway segment. This is an important connection to distribution and industrial facilities along Empire Ave in Bend.
US20 (Hwy 17)	4th Street (Tumalo)	Cook Ave (Tumalo)	0.4	Statewide freight corridor. Traffic congestion and safety issues thru Tumalo.
Empire Avenue	US20 Connection	Boyd Acres Rd	0.47	Important regional freight corridor identified by the MPO that connects US 97 to important industrial land off Empire Ave. This is a key first/last mile connection to distribution and industrial facilities along Hwy 97 (major freight generator).
Boyd Acres Rd	Empire Ave	Butler Mkt Rd	0.95	Important freight corridor identified by the MPO that connects to major freight generators to US97
